Building and Restoring Abilities Via Equine (BRAVE) is a group of therapists and parents working together to raise funds for the facility fee at Outdoor Wilderness Learning Equine Center (OWL center) where the children get to utilize the horses in the hippotherapy program. Hippotherapy is a specialized, hands-on approach to therapy involving horses. It is performed by an occupational or physical therapist and utilizes equine movement to help the child better reach their goals.

What is Hippotherapy? Hippotherapy is a specialized, hands-on approach to therapy involving horses. It is performed by an occupational or physical therapist and utilizes equine movement to help the child better reach their goals; whether the child is working on balance, core strength, motor planning, attention to task or fine motor skills, the horse's movement is used to stimulate the overall body. Therapy can be used to address motor planning skills and strengthen the child's body and mind by allowing them to focus on an activity, enhance self-confidence, and master fine motor skills needed for Activities of Daily Living.

Outdoor Wilderness Learning Equine Center is a riding program that serves over 100 children and adults with special needs on a weekly basis. The OWL Equine Center provides lessons and horses to at-risk youth and people with physical, cognitive, and emotional challenges. We are excited to team up with Building Futures Pediatric Therapy clinic to provide horses and assistance to their special needs children.

OWL Center is a 501c3 Nonprofit community-based program of the Louisiana Methodist Children's Home.


We have 3 semesters scheduled for this year; Spring is a 10 week session, Summer is a 8 week session, and Fall is a 10 week session.
