This allows parents of children without or with disabilities or delays to focus on their child's development and progress.

What is Hippotherapy? Hippotherapy is a specialized, hands-on approach to therapy involving horses. It is performed by an occupational or physical therapist and utilizes equine movement to help the child better reach their goals; whether the child is working on balance, core strength, motor planning, attention to task or fine motor skills, the horse's movement is used to stimulate the overall body. Therapy can be used to address motor planning skills and strengthen the child's body and mind by allowing them to focus on an activity, enhance self-confidence, and master fine motor skills needed for Activities of Daily Living.

What is Equine-Therapy? Equine-Therapy addresses emotional and social growth. As well as how to properly handle and ride a horse. Equine knowledge encourages leadership, confidence, teamwork, and improves problem-solving skills.

We offer 3 semesters a year; Spring, Summer, and Fall.
